PREFACE

Although the summary gives an impression of a Home's working in statistical and financial terms, it should perhaps be stressed that, comparisons based solely on figures, should be viewed with caution. It must be borne in mind that there are many factors attaching to the running of hospitals and homes which may lead to apparently surprising differences in costs, as between one and another, which could only be explained by a more detailed examination of the circumstances.

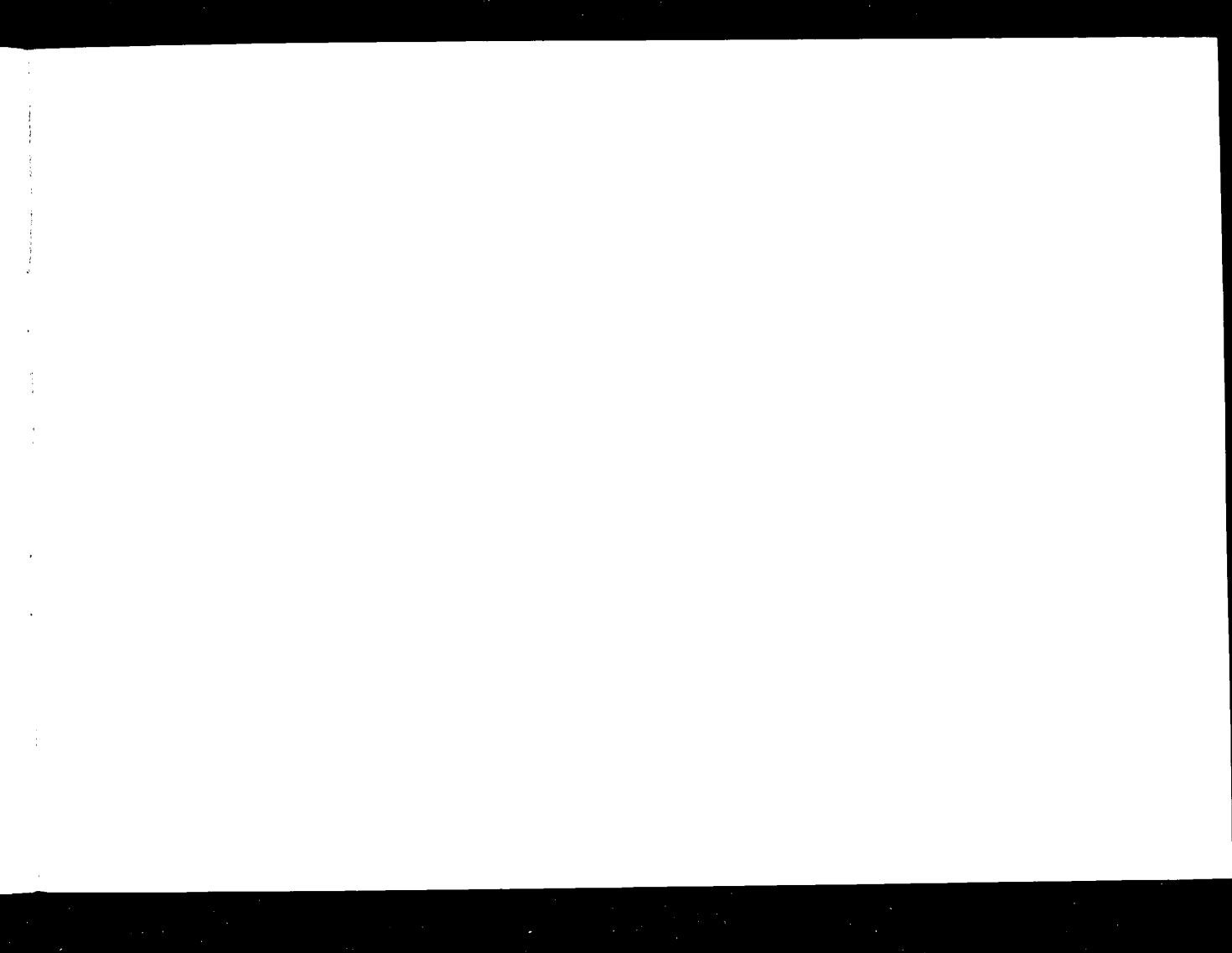
