Some hope is felt that this Fund, which is chiefly one supported by annual subscriptions, may be able to show increased revenue from this source each year, as the objects of the Fund become better understood and appreciated. One of these objects is, while avoiding the diversion of individual interest from particular charities, to secure by personal and impartial inspection that moneys are only awarded to institutions that properly deserve encouragement and support.

In this connection it was pleasant to receive a letter from the Worshipful Company of Drapers enclosing a cheque for £1,000 for an annual subscription at the pleasure of the Court of Assistants, accompanied with a letter in which it was stated :—

“The Company learnt, with much satisfaction, from the last Report of the ‘Prince of Wales’ Hospital Fund, that the Committee have appointed visiting Sub-Committees, consisting of persons practically acquainted with Hospital management, with the object of obtaining information as to the merits and needs of the various institutions. The Company regard this as a most important step towards promoting the well-being of Metropolitan Medical Charities and strengthening their claims on public benevolence.”

While the work of this Fund is limited to the London Hospitals, yet the Hospitals themselves are a centre of very wide influence, extending far beyond the limits of London ; indeed, to a greater or less extent they affect the well-being of the whole Empire, as they supply no inconsiderable proportion of the medical men whose services are afterwards devoted to all parts of the Empire.

In conclusion, the Council desire to record again the kind gratuitous assistance they have had from the Press in carrying on the work of the Fund. Some of the Press comments upon the work of the preceding year are included at the end of the information accompanying this Report.

Report of the Hospitals Distribution Committee

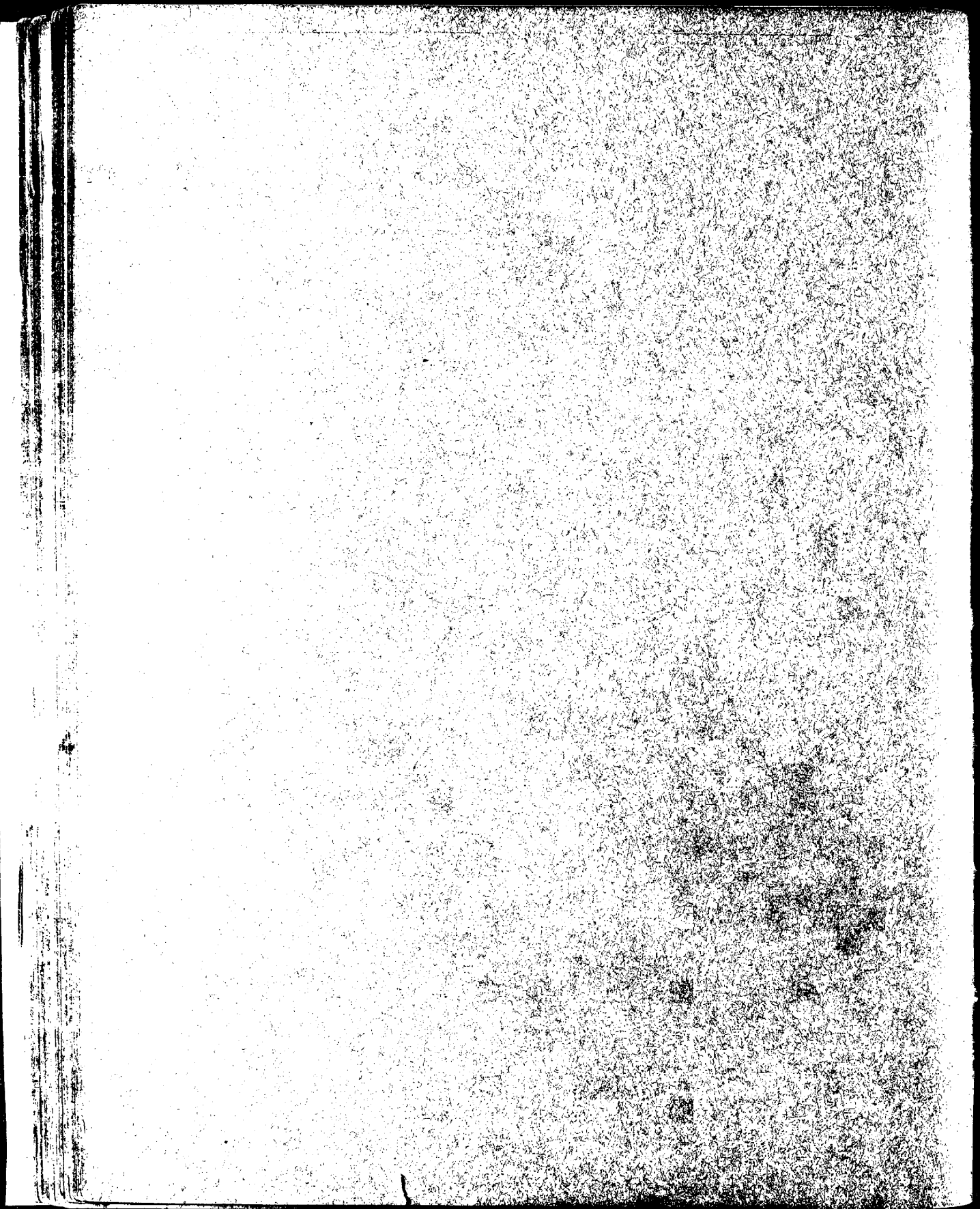
The past year has been one of increasing usefulness of the Fund. The Hospitals concerned have again been visited by Sub-Committees consisting of medical men of wide experience and laymen who take special interest in hospital management. These visitations, while they have admirably answered their immediate object of supplying reliable information regarding the merits and needs of the various institutions, have proved of very high* value in stimulating improvements both in construction and in all departments of administration. These improvements have almost invariably been cheerfully undertaken by the Hospital authorities.

The Committee have in several cases recommended that the grants from the Fund should be conditional upon the carrying out of measures which they deem important. The suggestions of the Visitors have been received in a most friendly spirit.

This year special attention has been directed to the pressing needs of South and East London, and the grants recommended have been accordingly substantially increased to various institutions situated within those districts.

The attention of the Committee has been directed to the objections, hygienic and general, which apply to a requirement enforced by some Hospitals whereby the in-patients have to provide certain articles for themselves. These articles include the supply of tea, sugar, and butter, changes of personal linen, washing, &c. After full consideration they have, in increasing the grants or in renewing the larger grants made to institutions where these requirements are enforced, called the attention of the authorities to the objections attaching to the system, and have requested that the articles in question may in future be provided by the Hospitals. Several of the best managed institutions make no such demands on the patients.

The Committee's anticipation that the League of Mercy, instituted two years ago by H.R.H., would in due time greatly benefit the Fund, is confirmed by the fact that the Committee are enabled to advise the employment of £6,000 from that source, this being the amount which will be paid to the Treasurer by the League in connection with this year's distribution.

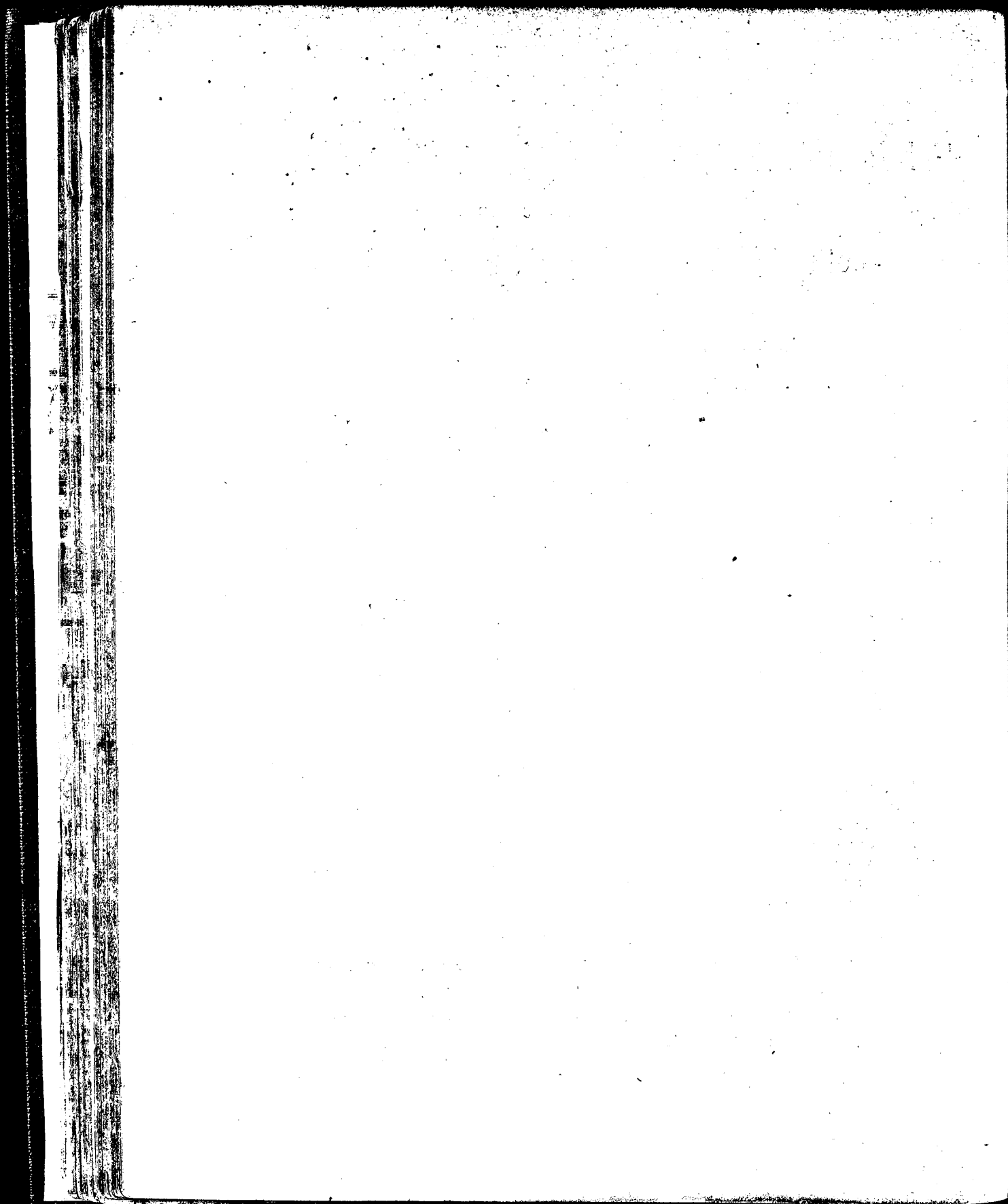

REPORT OF THE GENERAL COUNCIL

For the Year ending 31st December, 1900.

SINCE the end of 1900, the fourth year of this Fund, the General Council have occasion to mourn the loss of our beloved Sovereign, her Gracious Majesty Queen Victoria, who was the first Patron of this Fund, and in whose honour it was founded as a means of commemorating the Sixtieth Year of her Reign.

The words used on February 5th, 1897, by the Royal Founder, our present Sovereign, may be quoted :—

“ Having ascertained from the Queen that she has no wish to express a preference for any one of the many proposals loyally suggested for commemorating, nationally or locally, the sixtieth year of her reign, I feel at liberty to bring to the notice of the inhabitants of the metropolis a project lying very near my heart. Its object being to attach the sentiment of gratitude for the blessings which the country has enjoyed during the last sixty years to a scheme of permanent beneficence.”

The General Council hope that year by year the Fund will continue to surely and steadily grow and become a permanent memorial of the blessings of the long and beneficent reign of our late Sovereign, and one worthy of the great progress made by the nation during the years she reigned over it.

The War in South Africa has been continued throughout the year, and the public have been asked for considerable sums in connection with the various funds originating in this cause.

For this and other reasons it is very satisfactory to be able to record an increase of £3,000 in the total receipts for the year. Excluding the initial start in the Jubilee Year, the figures show continuous progress, viz. :—

1898	£39,272
1899	£48,536
1900	£51,549

Although the receipts were only £3,000 in excess of last year, it was felt that the claims of the Hospitals justified a larger distribution than before, and it was decided to award to the

Hospitals and Convalescent Homes £50,000, as compared with £42,000 last year, being an increase of £8,000.

No appeal was made to the public for eighteen months, so as to avoid any clashing with the various War Funds, but it was felt at the end of that time, shortly before the close of the year, that it would not be unfair to make an appeal, and one was issued on the 22nd November. The response to this was somewhat disappointing, but with some special gifts made shortly before the end of the year, it was only necessary to withdraw from the balance of the funds in hand last year a sum of £2,183. 8s. 4d. in order to make up the distribution of £50,000.

The League of Mercy was enabled to contribute £6,000 this year, as compared with £1,000 in the previous year.

The grants made to the various Hospitals appear in the Report of the Hospitals Distribution Committee, and it will be seen that the additional sum of £8,000 placed at the disposal of the Committee has been distributed this year mainly in the way of donations, because the special circumstances of the year have tended to lessen the support given by the public to individual Hospitals. At the same time the grants are in many cases made with a view to the improvement of the various institutions, as well as providing for the maintenance of the 287 additional beds which have been re-opened with the help of this Fund since its inception.

This Fund has continued its sympathy to the movement in favour of the abolition of the heavy rating of Hospitals.

The expenditure for the year has been £1,960, as compared with £1,853, or about £100 more. It must be remembered that last year's expenditure was considered a minimum. In comparing the ratio of expenditure to the sums received the result is practically identical, viz., $3\frac{3}{4}$ per cent. in each case.

In considering the expenditure there must be borne in mind not only the work required to collect and record the subscriptions and donations, the necessity of a certain amount of advertising for contributions and for announcing the sums received, but also the heavy statistical and other work that has to be done in connection with the annual inspection of the Hospitals applying for grants and the consideration of their respective needs and merits. The expenditure will compare favourably with that of other institutions.

In addition to the statement of the Annual Accounts there has been added this year comparative tables of receipts and payments for the four years during which the Fund has been established, and also particulars with regard to legacies that have been announced, both of which it is thought will prove interesting.

In spite of the exceptionally large demands upon the charity of the public occasioned by the War, the contributions to the Fund have not shown any serious falling off during the past year; a gratifying proof of increasing recognition of the importance of the services rendered by the Fund. In consideration of the unusual needs of the several Hospitals at the present time, it has been decided by the Executive Committee to place at our disposal for distribution to the Hospitals this year £49,000, as compared with £41,000 distributed last year.

It is recommended that the additional £8,000 now at the disposal of the Fund be employed mainly in the way of donations, because the special circumstances of the year have tended to lessen the amount given by the public to the support of individual Hospitals, and it has been thought better to supplement these deficiencies by special donations for the current year, rather than to attempt to place additional beds at the disposal of the public, for which continuous maintenance would have to be provided. It must not be forgotten, however, that during the last three years 287 additional beds have been made available to the poor of the Metropolis by the agency of this Fund.

The details of the grants and donations recommended for this year are added.

REPORT OF THE CONVALESCENT HOMES COMMITTEE.

In deciding upon the claims of the various Convalescent Homes, the Committee have to bear in mind that they have only a limited amount at their disposal, and that they are dealing with this sum under the terms of a special trust.

In these circumstances it has been deemed advisable to follow the same course as last year, by making the Grants fairly substantial rather than by multiplying the number of participating institutions. This course necessitates the exclusion of many Convalescent Homes, the names of which might under more favourable conditions have appeared in the following list.

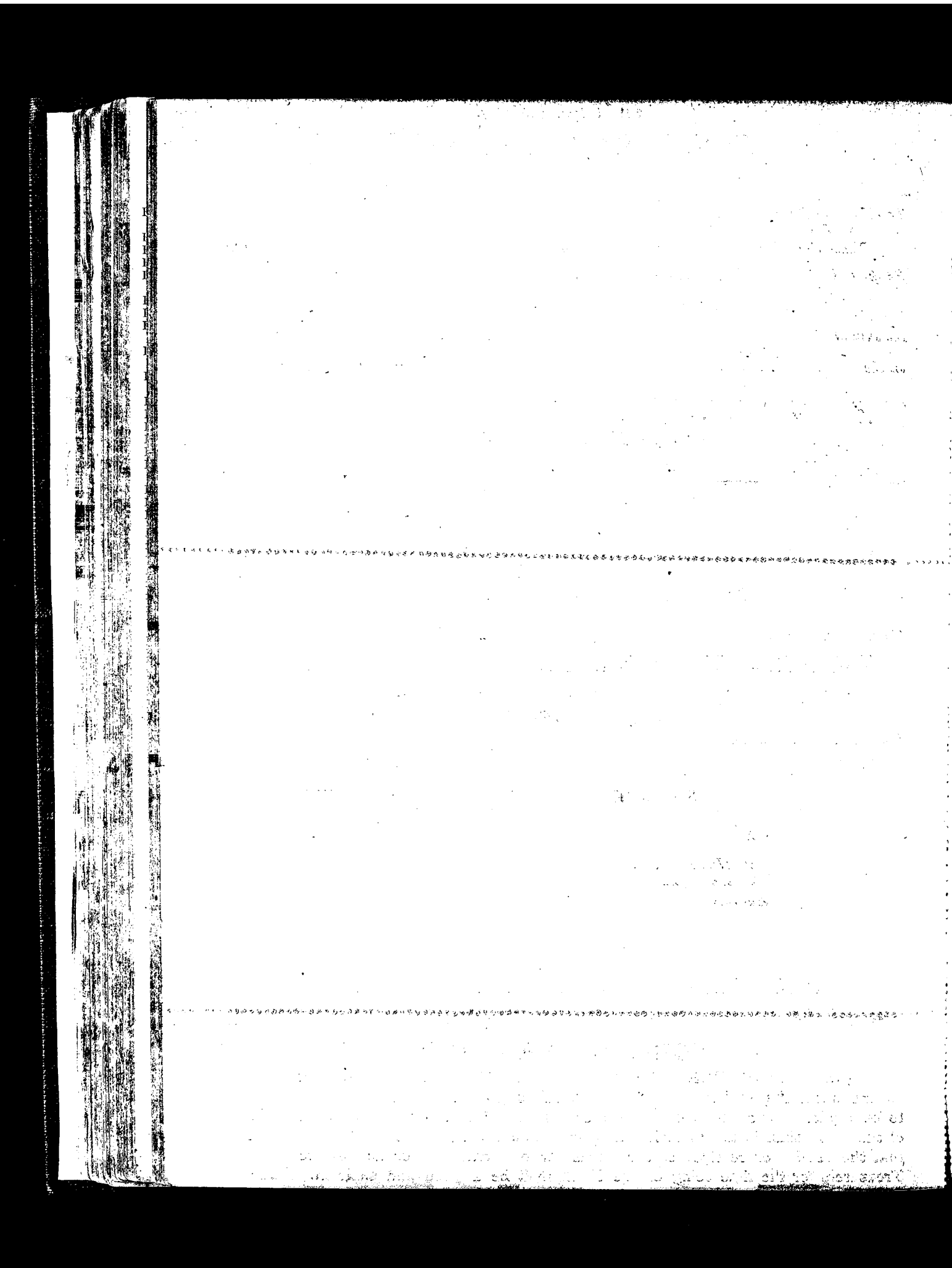

WORKING AND RESULTS OF THE FUND UP TO 31st DECEMBER, 1899.

THE TIMES, December 23, 1899

"The Report for the passing year of the Prince of Wales's Hospital Fund, which we published *in extenso* yesterday, seems not only to afford a justification for the existence of the Fund as a permanent institution, but also to display the care and sagacity with which its operations have been controlled . . . Together with the increase of income there has been a diminution of office expenditure . . . In a word, the whole of the arrangements appear to have been prudent and businesslike, and therefore well calculated to secure the confidence and to attract the moneys of the public . . . The Report on what may be called the department of investigation bears the signature of Lord Lister; and it gives deserved prominence to the statement that the Hospitals concerned have been visited by sub-committees composed of medical men and of laymen interested in hospital management; and that these visitations have not only answered their immediate object of supplying trustworthy information regarding the merits and needs of various institutions, but have also proved of high value in stimulating improvements in construction and in administration . . . Many grants have been special for the purpose of re-opening beds which had been closed under the stress of financial difficulties. Forty-five beds have been thus re-opened during the current year, and 242 in the two preceding years, making a total of increased accommodation to the extent of 287 beds; which in themselves form no inconsiderable hospital . . . It follows, as a natural result of the examinations made by the sub-committees above referred to, that a grant from the fund, and especially a large grant, is justly prized by hospital managers as a certificate of character. Qualities additional to character, however, are necessary in order to relax the purse strings of the fund; and hence the distributing committee has been careful, in cases where no grant is given to a well-known institution, to give the certificate of character without the money, and with an explanation of their reasons for withholding it . . . Persons desiring either to support a hospital, or to leave a legacy to it, could hardly do better than first to ascertain in what light its operations present themselves to the perfectly impartial judgment of experts—experts not only in medicine and surgery, but also in finance and domestic management."

THE DAILY TELEGRAPH, December 22, 1898.

"Reviewing the hospital history of the year, perhaps its most striking point has been the success which has attended the Prince of Wales's Fund. When the great project was launched not a few careful people expressed the fear lest an immediate response was being made in the enthusiasm of the memorable Jubilee year, which would cool afterwards. That anticipation happily has proved quite unfounded, and through the fund no less than 240 previously closed beds have been re-opened for the use of the suffering poor. The noble effort has, however, done something beyond that immediate and practical result. It has directed attention to the whole subject of hospitals, and the important place they hold in our complex social organization. It has encouraged hospital committees to greater exertions on their individual behalf and to exercise greater care in administration. Again, it has shown that giving need not be the luxury of the rich, and that the shillings and half-crowns of working people are as valuable in their degree as the generous endowment or handsome legacy. Meantime, however, the fund is not as great as it should be, and in many directions is not supported even yet as its grand aims deserve, while as an outlet for seasonable liberality its claims need no further words."

"The meeting of the General Council of the Prince of Wales's Hospital Fund, which was held at Marlborough House yesterday, had a very satisfactory record of actual and prospective work laid before it

... as a result, the sum which is recommended for distribution is more by nine thousand five hundred pounds than that ordered for division a year ago, and reaches the handsome figure of forty-two thousand pounds. The Committee had cherished the hope of being in a position to give grants amounting to a round fifty thousand pounds; but the urgent calls made by the South African War upon the compassionate generosity of the public have rendered that impossible. . . . If we look simply at the number of additional beds which will now be made available for occupation by patients, the advance is very cheering. The grants agreed to yesterday will add next year as many as forty-five, and credit to the Prince of Wales's Fund a total augmentation of two hundred and eighty-seven beds. That alone is a success, the achievement of which in three years affords abundant justification for the Royal essay in practical beneficence of which the Fund is the outcome. But the Prince's Fund has done even more. It came out very clearly in yesterday's proceedings that the administration of it constitutes an organisation not only for the reinforcement of the resources, but for the general improvement of the condition of the Hospitals concerned. . . . Everywhere the effort is made to render each Institution, in its own way, capable of doing its utmost for the benefit of those classes of the suffering poor for whom it was specially intended. These considerations are of great importance. It might quite conceivably have happened that such an effort as that made by the Prince of Wales would be shorn of half its value by a rigid and machine-like administration. But there seems to be the best reason to believe that this danger has been avoided, and that the Prince's Fund has become the means of quickening, in a great variety of ways, the element of intelligent and sympathetic human interest in the administration of individual charities."

THE DAILY CHRONICLE, December 22, 1899.

"The sub-committees which have visited the various hospitals, in order to ascertain their merits and needs, have had a secondary effect of great use-

fulness in stimulating improvements in construction and administration. Increased interest has been aroused in the welfare of these institutions, and subscriptions proportionately increased. The burdens resting upon the nation at the present moment in connection with the war are, we know, very heavy, but we feel confident that the permanent charities will not be allowed to suffer materially on this account."

* * *

THE GLOBE, December 22, 1899.

"Thanks partly to prudent administration, and partly to larger receipts, the amount available for distribution is nearly £10,000 in excess of the sum divisible last year. But this gratifying stimulation of public benevolence still leaves much to be desired. The total invested capital of the Fund is, at present, considerably less than a quarter of a million, yielding something over £6,000 in interest. The rest of its income is mainly derived from subscriptions and donations, two sources of revenue which must always have a more or less fluctuating character. It is of the first consequence, therefore, to augment the invested capital, as the increase in the interest obtained would provide a margin against shrinkage of the other sources of income. But to effect that vitally important object gifts to the endowment must necessarily be on a much more liberal scale than has yet been the case. The charitable have only to glance through the long list of Samaritan institutions benefited to satisfy themselves that any money they give will be judiciously expended. They will further find ample proof that working expenses are rigorously kept down; the present account shows fresh reduction under that head. The broad result is that, entirely through the agency of the Fund, 287 additional beds in London hospitals have been made available for the poor during the last two years. No other argument should be needed to convince the well-to-do that the Heir Apparent's happy and kindly idea is operating with a success almost without precedent among freshly-started philanthropic institutions."
