

FOREWORD

In the past few years there has been a strong movement supporting the development of group practice in health centres. These have clear advantages from the doctors' viewpoint and it seems likely, although it has not yet been finally proved, that there are real benefits for the patients.

The history of the health centre movement will be a fascinating chapter of the history of British medical services, demonstrating the interplay between the economic, political and psychological forces in the development of this new trend in medical practice.

The idea of doctors working together in a group has grown only very slowly and there is no doubt that many patients have appreciated having a general practitioner literally round the corner. Such doctors, even though providing a continuity of medical care and knowing the full family background, cannot, however, provide the best present-day medical facilities and make full use of the available paramedical workers. Dr Benjamin Moore in 1910 was perhaps the first to look towards cooperation rather than competition between doctors, an idea which became the theme of the famous Dawson Report of 1920, one of the most remarkable and farsighted documents in the history of the British health services. It proposed a network of facilities linking together the teaching hospitals, 'secondary' hospital-based health centres and 'primary' health centres in the community. It was the primary centre which was to be the basis of the whole scheme and which still provides the ideas of comprehensiveness and cooperation between the various health and medical services in the community. This theme was picked up by both Socialist and Conservative parties, and, although it was built into the National Health Service Act of 1946, there was a long way to go before a real start could be made in developing health centres. Although the idea received further backing in 1950 from the Central Health Services Council, and in 1951 from the British Medical Association, group practice in privately owned premises was increasingly seen as a more acceptable alternative to publicly owned health centres. To encourage the former type of group practice, the Group Practice Loans Committee was set up in 1953. By the end of 1958 only ten new health centres had been built in England. However, the problems of escalating costs of hospital services and the dissatisfaction of general practitioners with their role in the NHS finally brought, in the mid-1960s, action which really facilitated the working together of doctors in health centres.

By the end of 1972, there were over 500 centres providing facilities not only for doctors but also for the medical ancillary services. It is hoped that the full record of this movement will, when published, provide further stimulus for its development and its assessment both from the public and the medical points of view.

INTRODUCTION

This directory contains some basic information, supplied by medical officers of health, about statutory health centres in the United Kingdom. It is hoped that it will be of immediate use in its present form and, more importantly, that it may provide a step towards the establishment of a comprehensive information service on the subject.

Early in 1969, the King's Fund Hospital Centre held a conference, 'A new framework for community care', at which one of us (MPC) drew attention to the serious lack of information about health centres. Later that year the Centre invited representatives of executive councils, local health authorities, the Society of Medical Officers of Health and the Department of Health and Social Security to discuss the possibility of starting an information service. Although it became clear that there was a need for more information, there was little agreement about the type of information to be collected. As a first step towards solving this problem, it was suggested that the Centre might prepare and circulate a working paper which could serve as a basis for further discussion and development.

The working paper, *Directory of British Health Centres*⁴⁵, containing information drawn from local health authorities, was compiled and issued by the Centre in June 1971 in an attempt to gauge the need for information. This document was generally well received by the medical officers of health, executive councils, regional hospital boards and other organisations to whom it was sent and accordingly the King's Fund decided to publish an updated and expanded version.

Entries from the original working paper, to which was added outline information about new health centres, were checked and amplified by medical officers of health and it is this material that forms the basis of the directory. Editorial amendment has been kept to a minimum and has only been necessary for the purpose of clarification.

In response to a questionnaire, many recipients of the original working paper made useful suggestions as to how the information content of the directory might be improved and many of these have been adopted. Most, however, involved collecting *more* information, which many authorities were willing to provide, but which were beyond the resources available for the project. In the present edition we have, therefore, continued to restrict ourselves to information normally available to medical officers of health and we have asked for nothing that would have to be obtained from the health centres themselves by special enquiry.

Two of the areas about which many people wanted more information were staffing levels and routine clinics. Provided that problems of definition could be solved it seems possible to widen the scope of an information service in this way in future, and it may be that the administrative difficulties of collecting such information will be eased after 1974.

Perhaps the most important topic that was identified by the recipients of the working paper was the need for evaluation. To assess the part played by health centres in an integrated health service requires much deeper study than is permitted by the information in this directory. Although we have indicated the scale of the general practice, local authority and hospital elements in each health centre we have not been able to define the relationships between them, and between the centres and local hospitals. These, and many other questions, will have to be answered before the assumptions that health centres promote integration, and that such integration necessarily results in an improvement in the delivery of care, can be justified. Until this is done it is difficult to assess the value of health centres or to suggest how they might develop in the future.

COMMENTARY by Michael P Curwen

There is no sign of any slackening of the rate at which new health centres are being built and put into operation in the United Kingdom. By the end of 1971 the total count was 369, representing a six-fold expansion over a period of four years. During 1971, 118 new centres were opened. The annual rate may reach 150 in 1973.

Table I gives the numbers of new health centres opened, or expected to be opened, year by year, in the different parts of the kingdom. The figures for 1972 are based partly on forecasts made by the local authorities when information was collected for the directory. Although the building strike of mid-1972 may have delayed the opening of a few centres, the overall figure of 513 centres open by the end of 1972 cannot be far short of the mark. It should be emphasised that the numbers given for health centres due to be opened in 1973 and onwards relate only to those for which formal approval had already been given by April 1972. As we showed in the previous working paper⁴⁵ the *average* interval between approval and opening of health centres in England and Wales is slightly more than two years. It is to be expected, therefore, that many centres will open in 1974 and later, details of which do not appear in this directory. In particular the different procedure in Scotland is reflected in the large numbers of Scottish centres already approved and due to be opened in 1973-75.

The only measure we have of the size of a health centre is the number of general practitioners working in it. Even this may be misleading when a health centre simply provides a branch surgery for a large number of doctors, each working there for a few hours per week. Of the 752 centres listed in this directory there are 70 centres in which all or most of the GPs work for less than half of their normal working week. Table II gives the average number of GPs in 'main surgery' and 'branch surgery' health centres defined in this way. Taking only main surgery centres, the highest average is in Scotland (7.1 GPs per centre). No less than six of the Scottish centres (only one of which was open by the end of 1972) are for 20 or more GPs; there are only two other centres in the UK with provision for so many doctors. At the other end of the scale is Wales with an average of four GPs.

Although the appearance of large health centres (for 15 or more doctors) is a new phenomenon, there are still many small centres being built and the average size is not increasing spectacularly. The average number of GPs per centre (including branch surgery centres)

in the UK, according to the year of opening, are:

By the end of 1973 it may be estimated that about 1 in 7 of GPs in the UK will be working for at least part of their time in health centres. As the following figures show, the proportions will be considerably higher in Northern Ireland (1 in 3) than in the rest of the UK.

Table III shows how many health centres provide various special services. The choice of local authority services recorded in this directory is somewhat arbitrary, the general principle being to exclude services which can be provided by the general practitioner and his associated local authority team. Thus, antenatal care, cervical cytology and family planning are excluded. We have also excluded chiropody; in the 1971 directory this was shown to be provided in 69 per cent of health centres.

In almost exactly half the centres in this directory the local authority provides a school or priority dental service although in only 62 centres (8 per cent) are general dental services provided. In 14 of these, not open by the end of 1972, the number of dentists is unknown; in the remaining 48 centres there are, or will be, 79 dentists, 14 of whom hold salaried appointments. General ophthalmic services (only permitted in health centres since 1969) appear in three centres but there are many more centres (81) in which there is a school eye service.

Physiotherapy, usually associated with the school health service, is provided in 121 (16 per cent) of health centres. There are only four health centres where the regional hospital board provides a physiotherapy service, presumably for patients of all types. Regional

hospital board consultant services are listed as being provided in 69 centres, all in England and Scotland. Owing to difficulties of definition this figure appears to include many centres where regional board staff are, in fact, providing specialist school health clinics and not normal outpatient services. There are 14 centres (five in England and nine in Scotland) which list a wide range of specialties including, for example, general medicine and surgery, ENT, obstetrics and gynaecology. All the English centres and three of the Scottish ones are, however, in the grounds of hospitals and it has not been possible to distinguish between outpatient services actually available within the health centre and those in the neighbouring, or adjoining hospital building.

NOTES

The directory includes only those health centres established under Part III Section 21 of the National Health Service Act 1946 (England and Wales) and the corresponding legislation in Scotland and Northern Ireland. It has four sections.

The sections for Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland are arranged alphabetically by county. The section for England is divided into the standard regions used for the national census; North, Yorkshire and Humberside, North West, East Midlands, West Midlands, East Anglia, South East, London Boroughs and South West. Each region is then arranged alphabetically by county. The health centres in each county are listed under the county or county borough health authority responsible for their administration; those for which the county health authority is responsible are listed first.

The health centres themselves are not listed alphabetically. Those health centres that were, by April 1972, in operation, being built or formally approved for building by the appropriate government department, are listed in the order of their date of opening. Those centres that had, at that date, departmental approval in principle are mentioned as 'being actively planned'. There are very few authorities with no plans for centres and most of the entries, 'no health centres built or being actively planned', indicate that, at the time of compiling the directory, the local health authority concerned had plans in preparation, or had centres included in their capital building programme but had not had approval in principle.

Each health centre entry is arranged as follows:

The number on the left locates the health centre on the map of the country or region which appears at the front of each section. In the Northern Ireland section, the letters N, E, S and W denote the area health boards (see also note preceding the Northern Ireland section).

The date under the address indicates when the health centre opened, or, in the case of 1973 or after, when it is expected to open.

Use of the health centre for undergraduate teaching is also indicated.

Specific information on the size and range of services provided in the centre is grouped in three columns on the right of the page.

The executive council column (EC) lists the total number of GPs

working from the centre, the total number of patients on the GPs' lists who are seen in or from the centre, the total number of dentists providing general dental services (and the number, if any, of those working on a salaried basis), and general ophthalmic and pharmaceutical services.

The local authority column (LA) lists those health services (including school health services) provided by the local authority that could not be provided by the GPs and their associated nurses and health visitors.

The regional hospital board column (RHB) lists services provided on a normal outpatient basis. However, it should be noted that some authorities returning information for the directory may have included specialist clinics held by RHB staff for the school health service and which might properly be included in the local authority column.
